Document review records.

Practical 2:

94 P-2.1:	Records of the relevant administrative procedures and documentation to prove adherence to the fall protection plan policy as based on a realistic worksite where work is performed in a fall risk environment.
Range statement	The Fall protection plan must be based on at least one or more appropriate disciplines, that may include, but are not limited to: Fall prevention; Fall Protection; Rope Access; Ladders; Scaffolding; Mobile elevated work platforms; Portable or temporary access towers.
